Dionisio Herrera-Guibert is the Director of Training Programs in Epidemiology and Public Health Interventions Network (TEPHINET). Prior to joining TEPHINET, Dr. Herrera-Guibert was the Academic Director of the Spain Field Epidemiology Training Programs and a member of the Alert Unit for Rapid Response at the Institute of Health Carlos III Ministry of Health and Consume in Madrid Spain. He also served as Field Epidemiology Senior at the Institute of Public Health of Autonomous Community of Madrid, where he was a consultant to the Field Epidemiology Training Program. Other positions held by Dr. Herrera-Guibert include a consultant to the Minister of Health and Assistant Doctor of Family Medicine at the Ministry of Public Health, Havana, Cuba and as a Medical Doctor, Head of Residents, and Specialist of Community and Family Medicine at the National Reference Center for Primary Attention in Cuba. Dr. Herrera-Guibert also served as a chairman of the TEPHINET Board from 2002 to 2006 and a member of the TEPHINET Board from 2007. He is a Doctor of Science and from 2002 until 2009, he was an Associate Professor at the Complutense University of Madrid, where he is currently an honorary professor.
